To continue an Act passed in the Forty-second year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Act to empower the Justices of the Peace to make for a limited time Rules and Regulations for the government of Apprentices and others." Presented and Read a first time, 19. Read a second time. The House in Committee, 23. Report without amendment, and ordered to to be engrossed, 24. Read a third time, passed, and ordered to the Assembly, 40. Agreed to by the Assembly without amendment, 89. Royal Assent, 120, 121.

Further to continue part of an Act passed in the Forty-second year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Act to provide more effectual Regulations of Police within the Cities of Quebec and Montreal and Town of Three Rivers, also for extending Regulations of Police to other Towns and Villages in certain cafes, and for repealing the Acts and Ordinances therein men-

tioned. Presented and Read a first time, 20.

For the better regulation of the Press within the Province of Lower Canada. Presented and read a first time, 24. Read a second time. House in Committee. Report, and leave obtained to sit again, 41. Report with Amendments. The same agreed to, ordered to be engrossed and read a third time, 43. Motion that the said order be postponed. Negatived. The said Bill pas-

sed and ordered to the Assembly, 45.

For altering and amending an Act passed in the 36th year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Act for the safe custody and registering of all Letters Patent, whereby any grant of the Waste Lands, or other Lands of the Crown, lying within this Province, shall hereafter be made." Presented, and read the first time, 80. Read a second time. House in Committee on the Bill. It is reported without amendment, and to be engrossed. 84. Read the third time, passed, and Ordered to the Assembly, 86.
