

for leave to sit again on the further Consideration of the same; which Report the House agreed to.

Then the House adjourned till To-morrow, at Twelve of the Clock.

PRAYERS.

*A Bill to continue in Force the several Acts therein mentioned, was read a second Time Resolved, That the Bill be committed to a Committee of the whole House.*

The Treasurer pursuant to Order, presented to the House an Account of all Monies received by him into, and Payments made from the Provincial Treasury from 6th August 1794, to 20th Instant.

*Ordered, That the same do lie on the Table, to be perused by the Members of this House.*

Mr. *McMonagle*, pursuant to leave given, presented a Bill, in Addition to, an Act, passed in the last Session, for making, repairing, laying out, and altering Highways, Roads, &c. within the County of Annapolis, &c. and to extend the Provisions and Operation of the said Act, throughout the Province; and the same was read a first Time, and thereupon Mr. *Cochran* moved, that the Bill be dismissed, which being seconded and put, passed in the affirmative.

On Motion the House resolved itself into a Committee of the whole House, on the several Bills, which stood committed;

Mr. Speaker left the Chair,

Mr. *Pyke* took the Chair,

Mr. Speaker resumed the Chair,

The Chairman reported from the Committee, that they had gone through the Bill to raise a Sum of Money, not exceeding £2000 by Lottery, for the purpose of building Bridges, &c. and also, through the Bill, to amend the act, which enables the Inhabitants of the several Townships in this Province, (*Halifax* excepted) to cause any absent Proprietor of Lands, within the same, to pay a Dividend of any County or Town Charge, &c. and had made several Amendments thereunto respectively; and he read the Report in his Place, and afterwards delivered it in at the Clerk's Table, together with the said Bills and the Amendments. The Chairman also acquainted the House, the Committee had directed him to move for leave to sit again, on the further Consideration of the Bills, which stood committed: and thereupon Mr. *Cochran*, moved; That the Report of the Committee, so far as it relates to the Bill to amend the Act, which enables the Inhabitants of the several Townships in this Province, (*Halifax* excepted) to cause any Absent Proprietor of Lands, within the same, to pay a Dividend of any County or Town Charge, &c. be not agreed to by this House; and that the said Bill be rejected, which being seconded and put, and the House dividing thereon, there appeared for the Motion, Twelve, against it Eleven.
