    - From Lot 57, 127. Considered in Committee of the whole House, *ib.*, 128. Two Resolutions reported, recommending Addresses to the Lieutenant Governor on the subject. Committee to prepare. See *Addresses, No. 11.*
  - Petitions to work on Roads, in payment for Meal advanced by Government. See *Destitute Settlers.*
  - Resolution recommending that Road Commissioners be directed to enforce the completion of Contracts prior to the 1st of August, yearly, and furnish a detailed account, shewing the names of Contractors, and amount of Contracts, to be laid before the Legislature annually, 95.
