Mayor to authorize the issue of Debentures to the amount of \$150,000 for the purpose of building the same to the Guelph Junction Railway Company.

WHEREAS, the Guelph Junction Railway Company has been duly incorporated by the Parliament of Canada for the purpose of building a railway from Guelph to the City of Guelph to connect with the City of Guelph to the same and also to the junction of the Canadian Pacific Railway Company and the Canadian Northern Railway, between the towns of Milton and Galt, so as to form a direct line from Guelph to the City of Guelph;
