# **CHANGING COLOR OF CANADIAN STAMPS**

Ottawa, May 8-A nnumber of changes in the color of Canadian post age stamps are being made, to con form with the new international regulations. A straw colored one cent stamp is being issued to replace the old green cent stamp which has been in use for many years; and as the various offices exhaust their supplies of green stamps, they will be replaced with the new issue. The red two cent stamp is being replaced with a green stamp, and should a six cent stamp ever be issued it will take the red color hitherto distinguishing the two cent stamp. The five cent stamp is of a violet shade, while the ten cent stamp is blue.


