test foreman in his employ, and that the inspectors had to be down in the trench showing the men how to set the forms.

Mr. Taylor said that it was just what he objected to. He said the inspectors and not the foreman were running the job. As for the statement that the Taylor company had no competent foreman, Mr. Taylor pointed out that the city paid inspectors \$9 and that he paid foremen \$4. He asked which was likely to get the competent men.

Mr. Taylor claimed further that the inspectors stopped them for three days to remove a hump in the trunk sewer, during which time they were not allowed to put in any concrete, costing them \$125 a day.

The city engineer claimed that there was water in the trench, and that this water had the effect of carrying off the cement out of the concrete.

He claimed that on the Saturday at the time when the work was being done, the lamp was removed, and that there were two barrels of water in the trench.

Alderman Greenback asked if the inspector had stopped the work because the water was in the trench.
