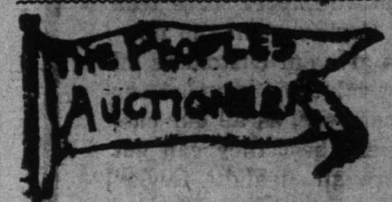

### Public Notice!

The following Regulation respecting skating and sliding on the Public Streets made under the authority of Chapter 36, Section 14 of the Consolidated Statutes (Second Series) is published for public information.

1. Within the Municipal limits no person shall "Coast", Skate or Slide down the hills or highway or streets except in the west end of the city from the crest of Falk's Hill to the Cross Roads, and in the east end down Robinson's Hill, under a penalty not exceeding Five dollars for every breach thereof.

NOTE.—The property of parents may be liable under distress for any penalty imposed on a minor.
