## TALKED OF THE REFERENDUM

Addresses by Rev. D. S. Hamilton and Mr. Frederic Daly.

Public Meeting under the Auspices of the Royal Templars of Temperance.

A public meeting was held last night at Somerset Hall under the auspices of the Royal Templars of Temperance. There was only a small audience present, due no doubt to the disagreeable state of the elements in the early portion of the evening. The chief feature of the meeting was an address by Rev. D. S. Hamilton, pastor of the First Congregational Church, in which he discussed the liquor act and the referendum. The chairman, Mr. Fred Daly, also expressed clearly his views on the question.

Chairman Daly, in his opening remarks, said that prohibition some time ago ceased to be an academic question and had become a political and a party question, it having been virtually adopted by the Liberal party, through the promises of Sir Oliver Mowat, Hardy and Mr. Ross, and by adoption in the Liberal convention in 1893. Mr. Daly disapproved of the referendum, because it was loaded down with so many disadvantages and distracting provisions. It was too complicated, and temperance people should ask the government to withdraw it. If the temperance people have no leader—no Joshua to lead them into the Promised Land—the speaker was in favor of remaining in the wilderness a few more years. If they could not have a leader, they should be content to remain in opposition. It would be useless to accept the referendum, for it could only result in defeat.

Rev. D. S. Hamilton, in an address which lasted about three-quarters of an hour, said that the liquor traffic is in danger because it is a dangerous traffic. It is of the devil, is doing the devil's work and should be destroyed. Ranged with the liquor men are found financiers who oppose prohibition because of the economic changes which it would bring. Their opposition is based on the solid ground of greed for money, and they should not be taken as experts on the question of prohibition. The opinion of the man who handles a Bible is a valuable opinion on a moral question of the man who handles beer. Because the traffic has been legalized in the past is no reason why the government should remain a partner in a disreputable business. The liquor traffic, it was noticed, took care not to show the government a sample of the product of this cherished industry.

The speaker said he could not help saying that Principal Grant, in uttering sentiments that could be quoted with approval by the liquor men, has shown himself to be a dangerous man to give advice to the people of this country. Principal Grant talked of the men of moderate views, and made a claim that they were the ones who had done most for the cause. The moderates have even been called to operation with the more respectable element of the liquor traffic, but said the speaker, the glided bar is more dangerous in the hands of the moderates. A considerable force is reckoned with, said Mr. Hamilton, is the indifferent portion of the electorate. A great effort should be made to arouse them to see eye to eye with the temperance people.

Those who recognize the evil and who have been fighting it, over-throw can be counted upon to throw all their efforts on the side of prohibition, whatever be the result of the referendum. The fight will be kept up till the goal is won.

Commenting on a reference to President McKinley's death in the speech of the speaker, the speaker said that while the nations were united to suppress anarchy, they were in league with the liquor traffic—the most fruitful mother of anarchy and lawlessness that the world has ever seen.

The need of the hour, said Mr. Hamilton, is for the temperance people to decide upon a definite policy, which should be settled at the forthcoming convention in Toronto. The speaker approved of Rev. Dr. Courtney's suggestion that Mr. Whitney be interviewed to see what he would be willing to do for the prohibitionists. If Whitney would go only as far as Ross has gone, the election of either would be an insult to the prohibitionists. If Whitney refused to do anything, the turning out of the Ross Government by the temperance element would not be a guarantee of better results. To refrain from voting would be to leave the election largely in the hands of an undesirable class, and result in the election of men favorable to the liquor interests. The better plan would be to concentrate efforts to elect a few out-and-out prohibitionists in favorable constituencies. Meanwhile, every effort should be made to secure amendments to the present bill. The temperance people should not submit, without protest, to the forcing upon them of a bill which is not acceptable in its present form and which would almost certainly be defeated. If the enemies of prohibition insisted on the bill retaining its present form, the friends of temperance would go on, poll as large a vote as possible, and not feel discouraged even by defeat. The prohibition question is in politics in its present form, and the latter has been placed under bonds for appearance in court.

who should be compensated—the men who have given their lives to the public, or those who have lost money and health through it? Any loss suffered by the introduction of prohibition would be more than made up by the resulting prosperity of the country.

The speaker closed with a strong appeal for undivided efforts on the part of the friends of temperance, and predicted the ultimate success of the cause.

Chairman Daly again spoke, touching upon the utterances of Principal Grant and Rev. John Potts. The former he charged with being largely responsible for the estrangement of the Presbyterian Church from the cause of temperance. Principal Grant, he said, always supported the party in power, never the party in opposition. Both revered gentlemen had axes to grind in siding with the government—Principal Grant looking to the treasury for aid to Queen's, and Rev. John Potts being solicitous for the welfare of the educational institutions of the Methodist Church.

The Advertiser also came in for a slight scoring at Mr. Daly's hands. He said he had taken it for many years, but that for the past three or four months he had been much displeased in the tone of its editorials. They showed plainly, he thought, that the paper had altered its opinions on the subject.

Mr. Daly said he feared the referendum would bring with it flagrant corruption at the polls on behalf of the liquor interest.
