FRUITGROWERS ATTENTION.

There is a present quite an epidemic a of caterpillars on fruit trees in Gloucester and Restiguahe County. These have been identified as the Tent caterpillar. They feed on the leaves and bloseoms of the tree and do enormous damage. They can be controled by burning them on the tree with a torch or spraying the tree with lead arsenate 2 lbs. to 40 gallons, arsenate of of lime 1% lbs. to 40 gallons.
