The Proprietors of the above call attention to the following IFIPORTANT DECISION of the Court of Chancery establishing their rights in the above, and GIVE PUBLIC NOTICE that their Solicitor has instructions to take proceedings against all infringers thereof :---

Between THE CARTER MEDICINE COM-PANY, Plaintiffs, and

JOHN CARTER. Defendant

INJUNCTION was PERPETUAL A granted by his Lordship the Honorable Mr. Justice Stirling, on the 31st January last, against JOHN CARTER, Chemist, of Woolwich, restraining him, his servants and agents from selling or offering for sale pills not being goods of the Plaintiffs' as or for the goods of the Plaintiffs by the use the term "Little Liver Pills," or by getting up his pills for sale in a manner calculated to deceive the public into the belief that the Defendant's pills are the Plaintiff's; also from supplying persons asking for "Carter's Little Liver Pills" or "Little Liver Pills" with pills not being the goods of the Plaintiff's: the Defendant undertaking to deliver up to the Plaintiffs, for destruction, all pill boxes, wrappers, and labels in his possession bearing the words "Little Liver Pills." The Defendant was also ordered to pay to the Plaintiffs their cost of the action.
