

also that part of clause 10 allowing ten per cent commission to the managers and agents of banks, the secretaries and managers of life insurance companies and of loan and building societies on the business from property in which these have a direct proprietary or hypothecary interest. The rules go into force on the 15th June next.

complete—with \$19,269; the Sun is third, with \$16,067; and the London Guarantee and Accident \$10,785. The total of claims incurred reached \$56,576, of which \$54,023 was paid. Under the head of "Unsettled Claims," resisted or unresisted, the Accident of North America and the London Guarantee and Accident are represented by "none—none"; the Travellers by \$2,000; the Sun by \$1,000; and the Citizens by \$350. The record of the Norwich and London is not a little singular; its total premium income was \$3,344, and its losses were \$2,550 of which \$2,238 still remained unpaid. It is to be hoped that the "Norwich and London" has some other means of support.
