ARTICLE I

Air Transport Charges for Closed Mails

The Administrations of the Dominion of Canada and the Soviet Socialist Republics have the option of collecting the transport charges prescribed in Article 11 of the Provisions regarding the conveyance of letter mails by air for each section of their inland air service.

Done at London, the 22nd day of November, 1929
