EXCELLENCY,

EXCHANGE OF NOTES

I have the honour to refer to the Exchange of Notes of December 31, 1946 (April 10 and 12, 1947) between the Government of Canada and the Government of Belgium signed at Ottawa on October 25, 1945, as amended on May 2, 1947.

By Order in Council dated January 31, 1947, the Government of Canada has authorized the Minister of Finance and Trade and Commerce, to make such arrangements with the Government of Belgium as are desirable to enable the funds received by the Government of Belgium by way of the loan agreement, in addition to the purposes of the said agreement, to be used for the purpose of providing services and to enable persons ordinarily resident in Belgium to pay for Canadian-produced goods or the cost of Canadian services.
