- FEDERAL GOVERNMENT PROGRAMMES FOR MANPOWER TRAINING AND RELOCATION, FOR REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT, AND FOR INDUSTRIAL ADJUSTMENT CAN BE EXPECTED TO FACILITATE THE ADJUSTMENT PROCESS INVOLVED, BOTH TO TAKE ADVANTAGE OF NEW OPPORTUNITIES AND TO ASSIST IN THOSE CASES WHERE, BECAUSE OF LOCATIONAL, STRUCTURAL OR OTHER PARTICULAR DIFFICULTIES, SPECIAL PROBLEMS OF ADJUSTMENT ARISE. THE EXTENT OF SUCH PROBLEMS WILL, OF COURSE, DEPEND ON WHAT IS EXCEPTED FROM THE NEGOTIATIONS, THE DEPTH OF TARIFF CUT AND THE PHASING-IN OF TARIFF CUTS OVER THE YEARS AHEAD. IDENTIFICATION OF SPECIFIC AREAS WHERE EXISTING PROGRAMMES OF ASSISTANCE MAY NEED STRENGTHENING WILL ALSO, OF COURSE, BE DEPENDENT ON THESE CONSIDERATIONS, TO A CONSIDERABLE EXTENT.
