further detail later in this report.

- A number of recent newspaper articles and surveys have referred to consumers' growing concern about food safety and the health value of various food products. These sources also note that fisheries products are considered to be healthier and less likely to contain additives or toxic chemicals. These attitudes should be of benefit to Canadian seafood exports, due to Canada's positive image in Japan.
