I have the honour to acknowledge receipt of your letter sub No 55, dated August 4, 1980, reading as follows:

Pursuant to Legislative Decree 1244/72 (Government's Gazette 181/A/1972) and in particular Article 3 thereof and Presidential Decree 271/76 and in particular Article 5 thereof, the Government of the Hellenic Republic is willing to conclude an agreement with the Government of Canada according to the terms of your above letter.

Therefore the Government of the Hellenic Republic considers that your above letter together with this present letter constitute an agreement between our two Governments which shall enter into force as from the date of this letter and shall remain in force until such time as either Government shall decide to terminate it by giving, in writing, six months' notice to the other.—
