6 Certain Laminated Hardwood Trailer Flooring (LHF) from Canada

6.1 Case History

On March 7, 1996, Commerce and the ITC accepted a petition filed by the Ad Hoc Committee on Laminated Hardwood Trailer Flooring Imports (Anderson-Tully, Havelo Wood Products, Inc., Industrial Hardwood Products Inc., Lewisohn Sales Company Inc., and Cloud Corporation / Cloud Oak Corporation) alleging injury to U.S. industry by reason of allegedly subsidized imports of laminated hardwood flooring from Canada. The petition also alleged that critical circumstances existed with respect to imports of the subject merchandise. The scope of the investigation consisted of certain laminated hardwood flooring made of oak, maple or other hardwood lumber.
