

GATT Ministerial Meeting chaired by Mr. MacEachen. On the bilateral side, they discussed the Canada-European Communities Long Term Fisheries Agreement, imports of seal products into the European Community, and the general state of trade between Canada and the Community. They agreed on the value of the growing commercial interchange and the importance of dealing with trade questions on the basis of full adherence to the GATT, which governs trade relations between Canada and the Community.

The Committee agreed that it would meet again in Ottawa early in 1984.
