## A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS HER MAJESTY QUEEN ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by Commission under the Great Seal of Canada bearing date the first day of August, 1959, was graciously pleased to appoint me to be during the Royal Pleasure Governor General and Commander-in-Chief in and over Canada, and further in and by the said Commission, authorized, empowered and commanded me to exercise and perform all and singular the powers and directions contained in certain Letters Patent under the Great Seal of Canada, bearing date the eighth day of September in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-seven constituting the office of Governor General and Commander-in-Chief of Canada and in any other Letters Patent adding to, amending or substituted for the same.

Now, THEREFORE, KNOW YOU that I have thought fit to issue this Proclamation in order to make known Her Majesty's said appointment and I do also hereby require and command that all and singular Her Majesty's Officers and Ministers in Canada, do continue in the execution of their several and respective offices, places and employments, and that Her Majesty's loving subjects and all others whom it may concern do take notice hereof and govern themselves accordingly.

GIVEN under my hand and seal-at-arms at Ottawa, this fifteenth day of September in the year of Our Lord One thousand nine hundred and fifty-nine and in the Eighth year of Her Majesty's Reign.
