TO THE BUILDING COMMITTEE:-

Preliminary Conferences.

On advising us of our appointment as Architeets for the Pathological Building, the Secretary of the University suggested that we should get in touch with Professor Certel and Mr. Webster, of the Royal Victoria Rospital, without delay. The first meeting with these gentlemen took place on April 10th, 1992. (Present:- Professor Certel, Mr. Webster, Mr. Nobbs, Mr. Hyde, Mr. Traquair and Mr. Carless). The general requirements of Professors Certel, MacTaggart and Bruyere were explained, and we received some notes and publications bearing on the type of building required.

On April 19th, 1922, we had another meeting. (Present: Professor Certel, Mr. Webster, Mr. Nobbs and Mr. Carless), when a preliminary lay out of the building was under consideration. A survey of the site had meanwhile been obtained, and the position of the building on the property was roughly determined.

On April 22nd, 1922, we spent the morning with the Consulting Architects, and had a meeting in the afternoon. (Present:- Professors Certel, MacTaggart, Bruyere, Mr. Webster, and Messre. Stevens, Lee, Mobbs, Traquair and Carless). A general discussion on our lay out
