I am willing to appeal to the Judgment of the Great Day to decide the question, as to whether or not what I have presented before you is proper for me to say, or proper for you to receive. May the Lord give us all minds to know what is right, wills to choose what is right, and the devotion of heart to do what is right, that so we may give in our account at the last "with joy and not with grief."
