River and Shabogama Lake contain pike and pickerel of immense size. By the northeast branch of Shabogama Lake, canoe trips can be made to Laurentian Lake through a region which is as yet practically unknown and unmapped. Here are dozens of beautiful clear-water lakes, full of speckled trout that rise hungrily to the fly, even in midsummer fish ranging from quarter pounders to 4½ and 5 pounds.
