## DRANK CARBOLIC ACID.

Mrs. Elizabeth Ekins Took Her Life While Temporarily Insane.

Mrs. Elizabeth Ekins, wife of Joseph H. Ekins, committed suicide on Wednesday morning at her home, 30 Calender-street, by drinking carbolic acid. Temporary insanity, due to the drink habit, is given as the cause of the act.

The poison was purchased at Gray's drug store on Tuesday, as a verminal exterminator. The woman was found by her husband, suffering the agonies of death, and Dr. Hart, Griffith and Yeo were summoned. Death resulted a few minutes after their arrival, and about fifteen minutes after the poison was taken, according to the statement of one of the medical attendants. Death from carbolic acid poisoning usually results in two or three hours after taking. A two-ounce bottle of the acid was found by her side, and about three-quarters of an ounce was found in the stomach.

Mrs. Ekins leaves a husband, two grown-up daughters and one son.

She was 42 years of age. The son is Sgt. Ekins of the O.R.B., who served in South Africa, and also went to England on the Coronation Contingent. The husband is employed in the T. Eaton Co. store.

The circumstances connected with the death were reported to Dr. Orr, coroner, who deemed an inquest unnecessary.

**Police Court Record.**

In the Police Court on Wednesday Charles N. Haywood pleaded guilty to several charges of stealing from boarding houses, and was sent to the Central Prison for 18 months. John Miles, for obstructing a policeman, charged with assaulting a constable on Oct. 2, was sentenced to 30 days. William Crasby was charged with the theft of a coat and other articles from Capt. John Miles' home, at 86 Wellington-place. The case of Joseph Cohen, charged with assaulting another constable at the Central Prison, was adjourned till Friday.

### PROBLEMS OF NEW CENTURY

Government Ownership of Public Utilities Only Means of Thwarting the Great Corporations.

W. F. MACLEAN OPENS NEW CLUB

Conservative Party Should Solve Industrial Problems and Thus Forge to Front Again.

Hamilton, Oct. 8.—The Twentieth Century Clubrooms, South Locke-street, were opened this evening for the winter season. Prominent Conservatives, including Mayor Hendrie, S. Barker, M. P., F. A. Bruce, M. P., J. J. Scott, K. C., Lieut.-Col. Moore, were present, and the attendance was large.

The evening and the principal speaker was W. F. Maclean, M. P., who on being introduced by the chairman, Ald. D'Arcy Martin, was given a most hearty reception. He gave a bright, interesting and instructive address on twentieth century problems. He pointed out that a new condition of affairs had arisen in the world of capital and that the problems caused by the change needed new methods to combat them for the good of the people. These must be twentieth century methods, which he dilated on.

**How to Thwart Corporations.**

Mr. Maclean forcefully presented his views on the government ownership of great public franchises, railways, telegraphs, telephones and the like, and argued that by that means alone could the capitalists and corporations be met and thwarted. The Conservative party, he said, had led in all the great reforms of the past and it was the duty of the party to lead in the new century. If that party wanted to come to the front it must work with the people and must make a worthy successor to the industrial problems of the new century.

At the close Mr. Maclean was warmly applauded and was accorded a hearty vote of thanks on motion of J. J. Scott, K. C., and Col. Moore.

Other speakers were: Mayor Hendrie, Samuel Barker, M. P., and J. C. Bruce, M. P. Songs were given by Aid. Hanna and J. B. Jardine.
