

SOCIALIST SAYS CRISIS CONFRONTS GERMANY

40,000 Unemployed in Berlin—Warm Addresses at Opening of Reichstag.

BERLIN, Nov. 29.—The 1908 budget was discussed in the Reichstag today. Herr Bebel, the socialist leader, called attention to the condition of the country and declared this indicated that a crisis was at hand. He said the unemployed in Berlin already numbered between 30,000 and 40,000. Owing to the industrial combine and the price agreement the day of low prices in Germany was passed and the high duties put in force in the month of March 1908, also were making things worse.

Consequently, Herr Bebel declared, Germany was paying the highest prices in the world. Holding up a copy of the Reichstag paper, he said: "They still say this is a big loaf, but a loaf that weighed 4-5 pounds eight weeks ago now weighs scarcely three pounds and the price has risen fully fifty per cent."

Referring to the recent trial of Maximilian Hildebrand, who was sued by Count Kuno Von Moltke, a former military-governor of Berlin, for defamation of character, the speaker asserted that the trial revealed in the course of the hearing of this case were so prevalent that if the police brought out the guilty parties to trial a scandalous scolding in the highest social circles and they include princes of ruling houses.

The police know the names of the victims but they are afraid to name the high personages who are guilty. A number of intrigues also have resulted from this state of affairs, said Herr Bebel, and some officers have committed suicide in order to escape blackmail.

Von Buelow Aroused.
 The sitting was notable for the energetic speech of Prince Von Buelow, the German imperial chancellor in defense of the army, the emperor and himself.

In replying to Dr. Spahn, the leader of the centre party, who asserted that conditions prevailing in the army recalled those of ancient heathen Rome, he said that he was not at all surprised that no one imagined that the whole army was affected by a few instances of unworthiness. He declared that he was not at all surprised the house, would be chancellor attended to by the emperor than whom no one could be more devoted to the morality in both the army and the nation.

It was the crown prince, he said, who had called his father's attention to articles in the Zukunft, disclosing corruption with the result that immediate action was taken. He pointed out that neither the chancellor nor the ministers could take such a step without holding proofs of their own guilt.

Prince Von Buelow then referred to the so-called court camarilla which is widely alleged to have been influencing the emperor's decisions. No one, he said, had ever accused the emperor of being without his own will and the camarilla acting as a puppet. He declared, was utterly un-German and repugnant to his existence. He declared that he had dissolved the Reichstag in order to protect himself against personal attacks relative to his supposed participation in intrigues.
