SOCIALIST SAYS CRISIS CONFRONTS GERMANY

40,000 Unemployed in Berlin—Warm Addresses at Opening of Reichstag.

BERLIN, Nov. 29.—The 1908 budget was discussed in the Reichstag today. Herr Bebel, the socialist leader, called attention to the condition of the country and declared this indicated that a crisis was at hand. He said the unemployed in Berlin already numbered between 30,000 and 40,000. Owing to the industrial combines and the price agreements the day of low prices in Germany was passed and the high duties put in force in the month of March 1906, also were making themselves felt.

Consequently, Herr Bebel declared, Germany was paying the highest prices in the world. Holding up a loaf of bread, the socialist leader said: "They still say this is a big loaf, but a loaf that weighed 4-5 pounds eight months ago, now weighs scarcely three pounds and the price has risen fully fifty per cent."

Referring to the recent trial of Maximilian Harden, who was sued by Count Kuno von Moltke, a former military-governor of Berlin, for defamation of character, the socialist leader asserted that the vice revealed in the course of the hearing of this case were so prevalent that if the police brought rose full of fire and declared that no one imagined that the whole army was affected by a few instances of unworthiness, the speaker means to say that the high tone of morality in both the army and the nation.

It was the crown prince, he said, who had called his father's attention to articles in the Zukunft, disclosing corruption with the result that immediate action was taken in the matter. He pointed out that neither the chancellor nor the ministers could take such a step without holding proofs of their own worthiness.

Prince Von Buelow then referred to the so-called court camarilla which is widely alleged to have been influencing the emperor's decisions. No one, he said, had ever accused the emperor of being without his own will and the camarilla could only exist where the monarch was willing. Such poisonous growth as a camarilla, he declared, was utterly un-German and requires regarding its existence as a stain on the house, would be sharply attacked by the emperor than whom no one could be more high-toned in morality in both the army and the nation.

Spurred on by obstruction, he said, the instruction offered by the emperor, which desired to test its strength against the nation's will. Any chancellor who had submitted to such a course would have forfeited the confidence of the nation. The chancellor promised to take part in the budget debate to-morrow.

Freiherr von Stengel, secretary of the imperial treasury, stated that direct taxation could not be raised in consequence of the increases in the estimates and the revenue, and rely upon the indirect method, but as yet he was not prepared to state by what means he hoped to bring the empire's finances to a sound condition.

The representatives of virtually every group, with the exception of the socialists, gave assurances that they were prepared to vote for the augmentation of the appropriation for the army and navy if it was necessary for the defence of the country.

Dr. Spahn greeted the emperor's visit to England as a sign of better relations between the two nations, and a step towards the maintenance of the world's peace, and the development of commerce. He then declared that the powerful centre party was utterly opposed to the proposed bill, which would give America and other countries a further reason for their imperialism that freedom was unknown in Germany.
