SETS NEW RECORD AT SYRACUSE TRACK

Russell Boy Paces Fast Mile -Bucelli Captures the Feature Event.

Syracuse. N.Y., Sept. 13.—Russell Boy, 2004, black stallion, by Rustic Patenter, today broke the record for the new state fair track by pacing the mile in 2.04. Driven by Geers, and the word "go" abouted by Governor Whitman, the exhibition event of today's grand circuit program stirred the enthusiasm of more than 20,000 spectators.

Bacelli, driven by B. White, captured the feature race of the day, the 2.07 class trot, for \$3000. First money was divided in each heat, Brescia winning the first, Al Mack finished first in the third heat, but crossed the wire while breaking. According to the rules, the judges gave the heat and race to Bacelli. Otherwise Bacelli's score would have been 2, 2, 2, and Al, Mack's 6, 1, 1.

Ima Jay had an easy time in the 2.11 trot. May Boy won the 2.18 trot, first division, in straight heats, winning a trophy, while Fighting Chance repeated the trick in the second division.
