

Montreal, Oct. 8—Announcement that Sir Frederick Donaldson, chief superintendent of ordnance at Woolwich arsenal, and Lionel Hitchins, of the Cammell Laird Company, were coming to Canada to assist in the work of further organizing munition and gun manufacturing plants in the dominion, was today made by A. E. Thomas, representative of David Lloyd George, British munitions minister, who has been touring the United States and Canada inspecting shell making factories.

Mr. Thomas was the guest of the Montreal branch of the Canadian Manufacturers' Association, and made this announcement in the course of a speech in which he dealt with the whole shell situation in Canada.

Mr. Thomas said that at first Canada was behind on orders given for shells, but had speeded up now. The shells being produced were of good quality. It had been suggested that an ordnance plant, under government control, should be constructed, and when Sir Frederick.


