FOURTH YEAR.

HEBREW.

Job, Chapp. III., IV., V., VI., & VII.; Proverbs, Chapp. I., II., & III.; Ecclesiastes, Chapp. I. & XII.

CHALDEE.

Daniel, Chapp. IV. to the end of VII.; Ezra, Chapp. IV. to end of VI.
