MANY VACANCIES IN SECOND AND THIRD DIVISIONS CIVIL SERVICE; FEW OFFER FOR EXAMINATION

Ottawa, May 25.—The Civil Service Commission today began the first examinations under the new regulations and it was noteworthy how few candidates there are for the second division vacancies. In that division there are 35 vacancies yet there are only 13 candidates throughout the whole of Canada, divided as follows:—Ottawa, 6; Halifax, 2; Montreal, 1; Toronto, 3 and Saskatoon, 1.

Few Men Trying.

There are quite a number of candidates for the third division but hardly 30 per cent. of the candidates were men. The numbers are, Ottawa, 109; Halifax, 11; Charlottetown, 3; St. John, 2; Quebec, 6; Montreal, 40; Toronto, 11; London, 5; Saskatoon, 1, and Vancouver, 2.
