The minister added that there was not a particle of foundation for the statement in the London Times, dated from Ottawa, to that paper, that the establishments of the various militia regiments were being reduced on account of the imperial forts on the Atlantic and Pacific coasts.

Colonel Tidale, ex-minister of militia, said in his opinion the people of Canada would not be satisfied to shoulder this heavy financial burden without more information than the government had already supplied.

"If it were only for the defence of Canada," remarked Colonel Tidale, "the situation would be very different."

"Canada is part of the empire," responded Sir Frederick.

On the Quebec estimates for harbor and rivers Mr. Monk asked that instead of spending so much money on small votes scattered all over the country they should make Montreal, Quebec, Halifax and St. John free ports.
