### A Son Instantly Killed by a Drunken Father - Grief of the Deceased Son's Afflicted - Full Particulars of the Tragedy.

New York, Aug. 22.  
 Another bloody tragedy occurred here this morning, in which a father figures as the murderer of his two sons. The scene of the murder was in a tenement house in Carmine street, where resides a man named Broderick, whose family consisted of a wife, two sons and two daughters. Mrs. Broderick being a feeble and tottering old woman of eighty, while the two sons, who are the victims of the tragedy, are aged nineteen and twenty-six respectively. Broderick, the father of the family, appears from all accounts to be of an exceedingly ill-natured and violent disposition when sober, and when under the influence of liquor his conduct is that of a madman. Frequently at late hours of the night he has been known to quarrel with his wife, and to beat her with a stick or a whip. On the morning of the 21st, he was again in a quarrel with his wife, and she fled to the room of one of her daughters, where she was joined by the two sons. Broderick, seeing this, rushed into the room, and, without any provocation, seized the two boys by the necks of their shirts, and, with a few blows of his fist, hurled them into the street. The boys, who were unarmed, fell into the street, and were killed on the spot. The father, seeing this, fled to his room, and there hid himself. He was discovered by the police, and taken to the police station. He is now in custody, and will be tried for the murder of his two sons.
