

exercising such other powers and authority for the well governing and ordering of the affairs of the said Corporation as shall be prescribed by the By-laws, Rules, Orders and Regulations of the said Corporation.

- 5 V. And be it enacted, That it shall be the duty of the said Corporation to lay before each branch of the Provincial Legislature, within fifteen days after the beginning of each Session, a detailed statement of the number of members of the said Corporation, the number of teachers employed in the various branches of instruction, the number of scholars under instruction, and the course of instruction pursued, and of the real or immoveable property or estate and of all personal estate or property producing income or profit, held by virtue of the present Act, and of the revenue arising therefrom. Accounts to be laid before the Legislature.
