er to the common gaol, there to be imprisoned for a term not exceeding two calendar months, the commitment to be determinable in every case on payment of the 5 amount and costs, or such penalty and costs may be also levied and collected by distress and sale of the offender's goods and chattels, under the authority of any warrant or warrants to be issued by such Justice or Justices, 10 who are hereby authorised and empowered to grant the same: and that all such moneys arising from any fines, penalties or forfeitures; under this Act recoverable, whether summarily or imposed by any Court, 15 shall be expended on the said road, or towards discharging the debts thereof, and that the evidence of any Stockholder of the said Company shall be admitted in proof of the offence, notwithstanding the application 20 of such moneys.
