

True Intent and meaning of an act of generall
 assembly of the Province of New York Entituled an act
 for the further and more Effectuall Prohibiting of
 Selling of Indian goods to the french. Resolved
 that Summons pursuant to the directions of the said ^{act}
 issued to the Sheriff of the City and County of Albany
 Commanding him immediately to bring the said Hans
 Hansen & John Schuyler before one or more of the
 Com^{rs} of the Indian affairs.. that they may be
 tendered the oath provided by the said act to be taken
 by persons suspected to have traded for Indian goods
 with any of the french Kings Subjects -

Magepanant a River Indian going to the upper
 nations was given by the Com^{rs} a string of wampum
 a Blanket & a keg with Rum to invite them to
 come to trade with the Inhabitants of this Province
 and to give them all imaginable encouragement
 & assurance that they shall be well come. and the
 Indian was promised ~~to~~ to be well rewarded ~~if~~
 if at his Return he brings down a large Company
 with him
