"I don't propose that any Canadian boys shall be sacrificed to maintain imperialism. The only course for us is to maintain neutrality whoever the beligerents may be"

In PARLIAMENT September 8, 1939, Hansard Pg. 47:

"I have boys of my own, and I hope they are not cowards, but if any one of those boys, not from cowardice but really through belief, is willing to take his stand on this matter and, if necessary, to face a concentration camp or a firing squad, I shall be more proud of that boy than if he enlisted for the war."

Coldwell and Woodsworth Would Not Help Finland
