Sir,-

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 11th instant, inclosing resolution of the Pottowatamie Council, recommending that Kenawanba be appointed guardian of the orphan boy of the late Joseph Quackashemah, the guardian to have the use and occupation of the boy's farm until he becomes of the full age of twenty-one years, the said use and occupation to be payment in full for the keep of the boy. In reply I beg to say that, in view of representations made, the action of the Council meets with approval, and Kenawanba is hereby appointed guardian of the boy on the terms specified in the resolution.
