Ottawa, 2nd March, 1915.

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 10th instant (No.C.186) and to inform you that the communication from Mr.McNaught of the 10th November last to which you refer, was not received at the Department. Possibly you may refer to your own communication of the 12th November last.

It is presumed that the Kootenay Central Railway has no intention now of passing through the Kootenay Indian Reserve No.3, which is situated on the East side of Windermere Lake.

I shall be obliged if you will be good enough to state to this affect positively.
