Dear Sir -

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 29th ultimo, with reference to the Sabisteq family. I regret that, as these children are half-breeds, not living on an Indian Reserve, no provision can be made for them in any of our Indian schools. Our Parliamentary appropriation is intended for the maintenance and education of Indian children only, or of those leading the Indian mode of life on reserves.
