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to an elevation of three feet above the level of the highway, as shown in red on the plan filed, and the trees trimmed to an elevation of ten feet above the ground, the brush cleared out, and the sight line established as shown in red on the plan filed.

That, subject to the carrying out of the work herein required to be done by the Department of Public Works of the Province of British Columbia, the relocation of the crossing at the point shown in black on the plan filed be, and it is hereby, approved; forty per cent of the cost of the work to be paid out of "The Railway Grade Crossing Fund," and the remainder to be borne and paid by the Department of Public Works.
