- 3. The draft Bill excepts the following employments from the benefits of the Act.
 - (a) Employment in agriculture, horticulture and forestry.
 - (b) Employment in fishing.
 - (c) Employment in lumbering and logging, exclusive of such saw mills, planing mills and shingle mills as are reasonably continuous in their operations.
 - (d) Employment in hunting and trapping.
 - (e) Employment in transportation by water or by air and stevedoring.
 - (f) Employment in domestic service, except where the employed person is employed in a club or in any trade or business carried on for the purpose of gain.
 - (g) Employment as a professional nurse or as a probationer undergoing training for employment as such nurse.
 - (h) Employment as a teacher, including teachers of music and dancing, whether employed in schools, colleges, universities or institutes or in a private capacity.
 - (i) Employment in the Permanent Armed Forces.
 - (j) Employment by Dominion, Provincial or Municipal Police forces. Etc.
