Reference G.S. 020905. Troopers
report that Officer Commanding troops Curacao con-
siders that company of The King's Shropshire Light
Infantry, now in Bermuda, is necessary to complete
security arrangements. Troopers therefore request
transport bringing first group of Winnipeg Grenadiers
call at Bermuda and drop one company to (garrison?)
Bermuda, taking on company of The King's Shropshire
Light Infantry for transport to Jamaica. Officer
Commanding troops Jamaica and General Officer
Commanding-in-Chief Bermuda being informed of this
request. Cable whether this can be carried out,
repeating to Jamaica and Bermuda. Ends.
