

13. To build and preserve roads, streets, bridges, and other public works, every male member of the band between the ages of eighteen and sixty, shall work when necessary under the supervision of the Council when requested to do so, or pay into the Treasury the sum of \$3.00 per day in default.
14. Any watchman belonging to the village who may show disrespect to the Council, or who disobeys any lawful or responsible order of the Council, may be discharged from his office by vote of the Council.
15. All fines collected by the Council shall belong to the Village, and may be used by the Council for the benefit of the village.
