



Joe Malone, the young captain of the Quebec team, was born in Quebec, and is just 21 years old. Joe is one of the trickiest centre ice men in the game. He played with Quebec Crescents in 1907, in the junior league, and also in 1908, when that club won the championship. 1909 he played lacrosse with the Quebec team which won the intermediate championship. The same year he played senior hockey with Quebec and the following summer played lacrosse with National, which won the intermediate championship. In 1910 he played hockey for Waterloo, Ont., professionals.
