## SPECIAL LENTEN SERVICES.

If it be desired to have a Special Lenten Service, it is recommended that the latter part of the Commination Service be used, commencing with the fiftyfirst Psalm.

The 'aily lessons at this season, from Exodus to the first book of Samuel, will be found, if carefully studied, to furnis' most appropriate matter for Lenten teaching: and this seems to have been one object of the Church in their appointment.
