Then the House adjourn'd till To-morrow Morning Nine o'Clock.

The Council acquainted the House by Mcsage, that they agree to the Bill for altering the Times of holding the Courts at Liverpool, and to the Bill in further Addition and Amendment to the Act to enable the Inhabitants of the several Townships to maintain their Poor.
