And also the Bill Intituled, An Act to explain and Amend an Act, passed in the Twenty third Year of his present Majesty's Reign, intituled, An Act for relieving his Majesty's Subjects professing the Popish Religion from certain Penalties and Disabilities imposed upon them by two Acts of the *General Assembly* of this Province made in the Thirty Second Year of His late Majesty's Reign, intituled, *An Act conforming Titles to Lands and quieting Possessions, and an Act for the establishment of religious public Worship in this Province, and suppressing Popery* having been altered and amended, were read a first time.
