JACK THE RIPPER.

LONDON, 26.—The foul crimes of Jack the Ripper were again called to mind last night by a murder that was committed in Rotherhithe, a suburb a short distance to the southeast of London. The body of a woman was found with the throat cut, as was the case in all the murders committed by the Jack the Ripper. Persons in the streets at the late hour at which the murder was done state that they heard a woman scream two or three times. They ran in the direction from which the sounds came and found the woman lying on the pavement with the blood streaming from an awful gash in her throat. She was unconscious when found and died a few minutes afterward. The police were promptly on the scene, and think the crime was due to jealousy of a drunken quarrel between the woman and some man whose acquaintance she had made on the streets.
