

Review for April has just been received from the Leonard Scott Publishing Co. The publication is a little later than usual, in consequence of the removal of the office from 140 Fenton Street to 41 Barclay Street, New York.

The first article in the number is a review of the lately published literary correspondence of Archibald Constable, the famous Edinburgh publisher, whose business brought him into intimate connection with the literary men of his time, and in particular with Sir Walter Scott.

In the article, "The Prospects of Persia," we have an interesting account of the physical characteristics of the country, its productions, manufactures, trade, government, &c.

Art. IV. "Precision for Public Worship in Large Towns," gives statistics of church accommodation and average attendance, and adds that the general inference is that the majority of the church-going population of England and Wales is to be found outside the established Church.

Art. V. "Aspects of the Agricultural Labor Question," tells of the strike that occurred about two years ago among the farm laborers of England, and the causes which led to it, and draws a vivid picture of the misery and poverty of these people.

Art. VI. "The Electric Telegraph." A brief history of telegraphy, with an account of the different instruments and codes of signals formerly and at present in use in England, the advantages derived from the postal system and a description of the main office in London.

Art. VII. "The New Parliament." Art. VIII. "David Livingstone." A tribute to the memory of this great traveller, followed by a review of his "Journeys and Researches in South Africa."

The remainder of the Review is, as usual, devoted to notices of contemporary literature.
