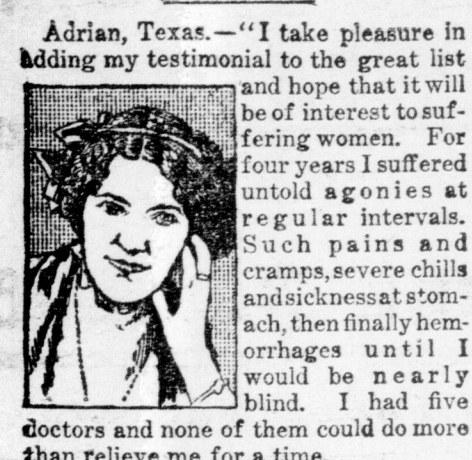

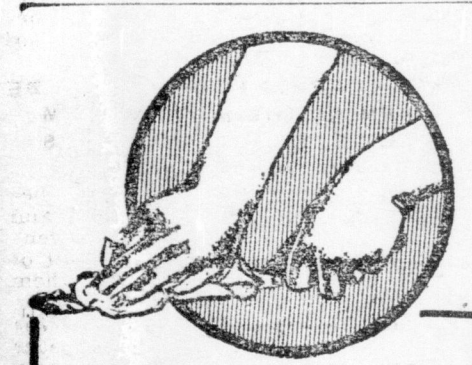

The "Lost Vancouver" which is dealt with in this publication, is that portion of Canada between Edmonton and Port George, and is a land abounding in big things, a vast and hitherto unknown section in the Central and Northwestern part of Western Canada—probably the most wild and romantic region on the American continent. The cover page of this book is printed in several colors and embellished with gold, the subject of the title page being an Alpine scene on the upper reaches of Mount Robson—altitude 13,700 feet—the highest mountain in the Canadian Rockies. The inside is printed on fine cream-colored, rough, and the illustrations give one a splendid idea of this new magnificent mountain district that has been pierced by the Grand Trunk Pacific. Included in the book is a new map of the territory and the best one that has been published, having been compiled in part from topographical surveys by the Alpine Club of Canada and the surveys of the Geological Survey of Canada. 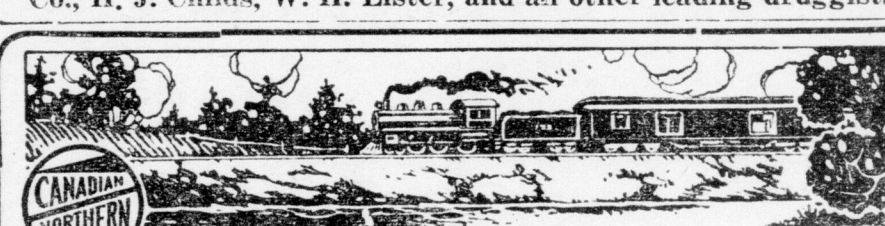
