go more fully into the aspects of the case.

Continuing, he said: "I am more than compensated for the loss of my position, if it be a loss, because I value following the dictates of my conscience and the approval of my friends more than I do \$5000 a year or five times \$5000. (Applause.) When the time comes when I have to choose between following the dictates of my conscience and holding a position, I will not have a moment's hesitation. I am here to-night without a position, without the position I held for three years; a position which in many respects I liked very well, but in which I could not continue any longer and advocate the principles you and I hold so dear. (Applause.)

"When I found that the Government in their anxiety to propitiate the Roman Catholic church and accept its dictation, when this question of the Manitoba schools came up after the opinion of the Privy Council was given for the decision was not mandatory, it was but an opinion that you could get from any lawyer—when I saw that the Government was so anxious to obey the behests of these men that they did not care to receive that opinion, but immediately summoned Manitoba to come to Ottawa and state their case, when I saw all this I for one said that I would never bow the knee to Baal.

"He went on to say that if the Public schools were good enough for the other children they were good enough for the children of Roman Catholics, and he would never consent to impose a system of separate schools on Manitoba against the will and judgment of that province.

The people of Manitoba knew their own wants and they did not want separate schools.

What It Must Come To.

Separate schools in Manitoba meant separate schools in all the provinces that were yet to be created out of the vast territories of the Northwest. That was the reason why the people of Manitoba were fighting so hard against the people of Quebec were fighting so strongly for separate schools in Manitoba.

He referred to the resolution adopted at a meeting in Peterboro expressing confidence in Sir Mackenzie Bowell, and said that he was astonished at that until he learned that the meeting was made up of five people and all were office seekers. "At this juncture," he went on, "I am sorry to say I haven't the confidence in Mr. Bowell's Government. I severed my connection with that Government, but I didn't do it until the last minute."

At this point a gentleman named R. R. Holt, who, according to the chairman was not an invited guest, began to interrupt the speaker and refused to be silenced.

"What do you mean?" asked Mr. Wallace.

"He doesn't know himself," some one volunteered.

"I don't think he does," said Mr. Wallace. But he is in the service of the Government," said Mr. Holt.

"Well, he was in the service of the Government 10 days ago," replied Mr. Wallace, "because I got him the job myself."

There was a tremendous cheer at the expense of the interrupter, but he still continued to place himself in evidence.

Mr. Wallace closed by saying that he was glad to know that in the fight of the future they would be found by side and shoulder to shoulder, fighting for the principles they thought best for the whole country.

The Other Speakers.

A HAMILTON WOMAN THIS TIME.

Mrs. Mary Senor Committed Suicide in Buffalo—Trouble Charged to Her.

Hamilton, Dec. 18.—Mrs. Mary Senor, 27 years old, wife of a motorman on the Buffalo and Niagara Electric Railway, who committed suicide at their home near Tonawanda, N.Y., on Monday night by taking a large dose of carbolic acid, was a daughter of Mrs. O'Neill of this city, and her remains were brought to Hamilton for burial.

R. Bowker, the Toronto insurance broker, was in the city to-day and as a result of his visit Secretary Jas. Cotter of the Army and Navy Veterans has been served with a summons to attend the Police Court and answer to a charge of carrying on an insurance business contrary to the act.

Pearl Travers, a girl who was arrested at the house of Killy Mack in Barton-street west yesterday, charged with concealing the birth of her child, will be tried on Friday. Dr. Wardell, who attended the girl during her confinement, says the child was still-born.

The girl is well educated and refined and was persuaded to leave home because she could not agree with her step-mother. She is the daughter of a well-known sea captain who sails from New York. Since leaving home she resided in a city near New York State until her money gave out and has since been living in houses of ill-repute. She came to Hamilton from Brantford.

Miss Morton, head teacher at the West-avenue school, has received a summons charging her with assaulting a scholar named Harry Fricker. Complainant's face and legs bear marks of violence and he alleges Miss Morton inflicted them.

MR. CORBY RETIRES.

The Popular Member for West Hastings Issues a Letter to the Electors.

Belleville, Dec. 18.—The Executive of the West Hastings Conservative Association, consisting of the president, vice-president and the Executive Committee, met last night at the call of the president, Col. Upstall of Trenton. Mr. J. J. Willis acted as secretary. The president read a letter from Mr. E. Corby, M.P., stating that he desired to resign from his position as representative for West Hastings and be placed his resignation in the hands of the association to be dealt with as they considered best.

Mr. Corby's letter gives the reasons for his resignation, which are briefly that his physical condition has deteriorated and he is unable to perform the duties of the office. A committee was appointed to draft a resolution in which it was recommended that the resignation be not accepted.

A resolution was passed expressing the regret for his speedy return from abroad with health fully restored.
